Mini Grants for Pre-licensing Preparation

The Education and Research Corporation in support of entry into the clinical laboratory science professions through less traditional routes offers small grants to persons needing supplemental preparation. These monies are intended to cover expenses associated with examination review seminars. The grants are unrestricted.

Criteria:

- Applicant may not be currently in a clinical laboratory science training program
- Applicant must be registered for an examination review seminar in California in preparation for California state licensing
- Should applicant attend a CAMLT sponsored examination review seminar fees may be waived in lieu of cash award
- Applicant may apply for funding one time only

Application is by letter and must include a statement of financial need. Awards are reviewed and granted individually and recipients will be determined by the E&R board members. Awards vary based on need but will not exceed \$500.

Application letters need only be one or two pages in length. They should be addressed to the Education and Research Corporation in care of the CAMLT executive office. Letters should include the review session the applicant will be attending as well as the date and location of the session. Applicants must also give a brief statement explaining their financial need.
